About JRS

The Jesuit Refugee Service (JRS) is an international organization of the Catholic Church, founded in 1980, under the responsibility of the Society of Jesus. The mission of JRS is to “Accompany, Serve, and Advocate” for all refugee’s individuals, forcibly displaced people, and people who are migrants in particularly vulnerable situations. It is currently present in more than 50 countries worldwide.

In Portugal, JRS began it’s activities in 1992, and since then, it’s work with our users has developed in various areas. Notably, it includes socio-legal support and assistance in accessing different services, helping them exercise their rights and overcome obstacles in their process of regularization and integration into the Portuguese community.

What is CLAIM?

CLAIM’s (Local Support Centers for Migrant Integration) aim to support the integration of migrants by offering a variety of essential services and support to facilitate their integration at the local level in the Portuguese community.

CLAIM Santa Clara has been part of JRS Portugal since 2003, aiming to support migrants individuals during their integration process in the national territory. This is achieved through individual assistance and guidance, as well as informational sessions on the rights and duties of migrants individuals, immigration law, asylum law, and Portuguese nationality. For about 21 years, it has been part of the National CLAIM Network, currently managed by AIMA - Agency for Integration, Migration and Asylum.

- Mental health support
- Support for initial learning of the Portuguese language
